

BVI moves to “white list”

Introduction

At the last G20 meeting in London in April the concept of a white and grey list of tax havens was introduced. In order to be considered as being on the “white list” a country had to have concluded 12 information sharing agreements.

It was announced on August 11, 2009 that the BVI was now signing its 12th agreement with New Zealand and was consequently now entitled to inclusion on the “white list” joining Jersey and the Isle of Man.
